
Health & Wellness: Penn State Survey



Health & Wellness Survey: Gender Diverse and Queer Clinic

The Gender Diverse and Queer Clinic (GDQC) is an IU School of Medicine student-run clinic that provides free care to patients who are uninsured, underinsured, and/or do not qualify for Medicaid, Medicare, or other free medical programs, with a focus on safe and affirming primary care for LGBTQ+ patients. The GDQC operates in partnership between IU School of Medicine and IU Health one Sunday per month at 1302 S. Rogers St. in Bloomington, Indiana, from 9am-1pm. Services include preventative care, mental health services, sexually transmitted infection testing, patient education on vaccination, resources for patients experiencing housing crises and/or substance use, connections to gender-affirming community organizations, and referrals to Indianapolisbased gender services. Patients can expect to be greeted by IU School of Medicine students and fill out introductory paperwork in the waiting room. They will then be welcomed to a private room to discuss goals of care and medical concerns with a few medical students. After this, the medical students will come back with a board-certified Family Medicine physician who will complete the visit and discuss treatment options. Patients can expect to pay \$0 for their visit with the GDQC. Because we don't have a formulary on site, we will help


Did you know that the first penny press (a.k.a. a penny smashing machine) debuted at the Chicago's World Fair in 1893? Since that time these unique machines have popped up around the world and are highly sought by tourists and collectors alike. What does a penny smashing machine do? Well, it should come as no surprise that it smashes pennies. It does so while also imprinting a special design into the coin. Children of all ages love to crank the handle and feel the pressure build as the penny is compressed and imprinted. Spencer Pride is proud to host Owen County's only penny smashing machine, which has arrived just in time for the eclipse! The Spencer Pride machine features 5 designs, each featuring a special place in Spencer. The penny smashing machine was sponsored in part by Babbs, the Historic Tivoli Theatre, McCormick's Creek State Park, and Sweet Owen Convention & Visitors Bureau. Each coin takes 4 quarters and one penny (just \$1.01 for an awesome souvenir!).



Our goal for 2024 is to grow our Sustainer program to cover 100% of our center's operating costs.


